A call to action for estimators to get in the game! Hear from an owner's perspective about the benefits of early involvement from estimating by leveraging Lean concepts including:

- Setting clear expectations What does success look like to you?:
 - Vision Statement what does the owner want to get out of a project
 - Conditions of Satisfaction what do the A/E/GC/Trades want to get out of a project
- Budget tracking for cluster groups
 - Tying dollars to scope
 - Transparently communicating risks and opportunities
 - Never say, "Yes." when you should say, "Yes, but..."
- o Open lines of communication with the design team
 - Pull planning for design
 - Set-based design
 - Presenting alternatives using Choosing By Advantages
 - Documenting decisions using A3 decision making processes

Many estimators may not find themselves currently in a position to leverage these tools with their clients, but my hope is that when the call comes, you'll be ready!
